Election time in Hanney

Local elections are to be held here on 2nd May, but only for our District Councillors. Sadly there were fewer candidates than there are places for our Parish Councillors, so an election is not necessary. (Apparently, this is the situation in 70% of the parishes of Oxfordshire.) Good news in one sense though, since the PCs have to fund their elections and they can cost over £2,000.

There are District Council elections to vote in - three candidates here....Conservative, Lib Dem and UKIP. Meantime, we say goodbye to four Parish Councillors and to the four new ones we wish the very best of luck. Huge thanks must go to the retiring Councillors who've finally hung up their rock'n'roll shoes...Jim Triffitt and Judy Long from East Hanney, and Chris Surman and Kay Sayers from West Hanney. Between them they have notched up over 55 years of voluntary service as councillors! Amazing.

Crossing latest... a recent East Hanney Parish Council meeting was the opportunity for folk to have their say on the proposed A338 pedestrian crossing. Good news!... All attending were in favour. No one objected to the additional lights that will be required, and the loss of some of the long hedge wasn't even mentioned. The message is loud and clear...it's now time to get on with it. Being the eternal optimist that I am, I've taken some encouragement from a recent statement by a very senior person within Oxford County Council, who said recently "....it is important that this crossing is implemented as soon as possible." Hear hear!

Our Community Shop needs help with the so -called 'milk and bread run'. This is a trip, made 3 times a week, on a rota basis, to the Co-op in Grove, where bread, milk and savoury stuff...pies, sausage rolls, scotch eggs etc. are collected, brought back to the shop, priced and put on the shelves. Each trip takes about 1 hour and currently volunteers 'do' a turn about once every 4 - 6 weeks. It's very flexible and all of us involved help each other with covering someone's turn if they are unavailable. East Hanney Parish Council



West Hanney Parish Council

Two members have decided to retire from Parish Council duties this year. Chris Surman and Kay Sayers will both therefore leave in May. A new Chairman will be elected at the May PC Meeting. David Corps has already applied and been accepted by the authorities as a new member of West Hanney Parish Council and we welcome him to the

team. There is still a vacancy however, so please consider finding out more about serving our village in the role of Councillor.

Despite strong objections by both East and West Hanney Parish Councils, Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) are at present still planning to widen the Cow Lane BOAT (Byway open to all traffic). The area in

question is the 182 metres southwards from School Road to a point where the footpath leads across the fields towards the church. OCC claim that old maps show the track used to be much wider than at present, and so propose to widen it up to 17 metres. That would make it probably twice as wide as School Road ! We have found maps showing an old width of between 10 to 16 feet, no more, but OCC are refusing to accept this. We are suggesting that they have got their metres confused with feet, but at the moment are getting nowhere.



Several residents have registered concern over the fence that has been erected across the field owned by Sweetcroft. We have met and had discussion with Glen Chapman, Sweetcroft Director, several times. There is no intention, and never has been, of blocking off any public rights of way.

We have now received

the very kind legacy left by Wanda Reynolds for trees to be planted in the village, and these will be selected and planted at an appropriate time in the Autumn.
