Hanney Film Night in the Owen Wright Cinema in the Village Hall

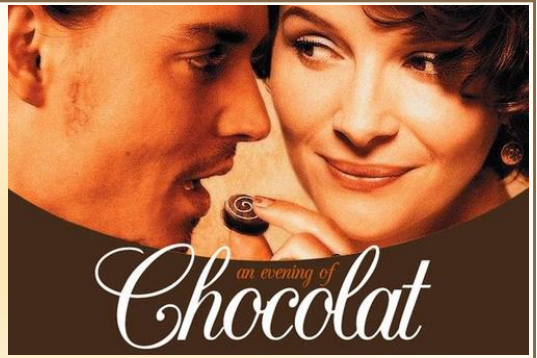

Many thanks to Ali and Kevin. Please join both groups; they are great community assets.

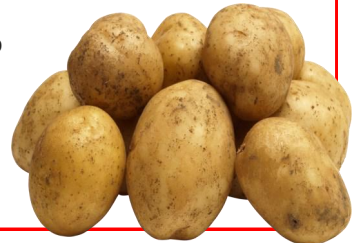


MICHAELMAS FAYRE 2020 - and the date is..... Saturday 26th September 2020

You will have seen elsewhere in this august journal, the details of the **'Tremendous Tree Planting'** event in East Hanney on the 14th March. The Oxfordshire County Council consultation for the pedestrian crossing, a Puffin Crossing planned for the A338 is now open. It is open until the 6th March 2020.

OCC's Cabinet Member for Transport will consider any objections or concerns in late March, after the consultation has closed.

The Parish Council continues to pressure the County Council for a time frame for replacing the bridge at Lower Mill, which connect Halls Lane and Cow Lane. Sadly, there is no firm answer as yet.

Soon, the village gates and speed indicator device poles will be installed. The recent storms have caused some delays but it is hoped they will be installed soon. That will allow the Parish Council, which intends to purchase Speed Indicator Devices before the end of the financial year, to start placing them around the village. Happily, the Parish Council was successful in obtaining a grant to meet half of the cost of one device.

The Council's meeting dates for the remainder of the civic year are as follows: Weds 4th March 2020 and Weds 8th April 2020, starting at 7.30pm.

Neighbourhood Plan Progress

Parish Councillors met with the Vale of White Horse District Council to discuss the feedback on our Neighbourhood Plan from the consultation stage of the planning process. Oxfordshire County Council were very positive about our plan. The Vale however did not like our policies concerning our village development boundary or the map of the 'Hanney Gap.' After discussion, the Vale agreed a way forwards which requires some modifications to both the map, the Development Boundary policy and the Location of Development policy. Once these are completed then a further discussion with the Vale will be scheduled. This is a really important step forward for the implementation of our Village Plan.

Highways Issues in West Hanney

The work to prevent flooding in Church Street continued in January with another section of pipework being replaced. However, cameras show one more blockage that need to be rectified, which will necessitate closing the entrance to St James Way for a short period of time. This work is being planned, and those affected will be notified ahead of any work taking place. At the time of writing Church Lane has once again flooded following heavy rains but once this work is completed the water should have a free passage to the drainage ditches.

Speed Cameras

WHPC installed speed cameras last year, on

the three roads coming into our village. We are now analysing the data that has been generated over the past six months and will share the detailed findings at a later date. We monitor the number of vehicles travelling in both directions through the camera, the speed of the vehicles and the time of day. For example during the past six months there were close to 1 million vehicle movements, both incoming and outgoing. The good news is that the majority, 93%, of incoming vehicles passing the speed monitoring devices, abide by the 30 mph speed limit. However that still leaves a significant minority of vehicles that are being driven at excessively high speeds through West Hanney. This will be the subject of further investigation and other speed enforcement measures over the coming months.

Pot Holes - we need a volunteer 'Fix My Street Super User'

The County Council Highways Department has set up a program of 'Fix My Street Super Users' whereby each Parish Council can report road damage directly to the County Council's contractors who will then fix it. We need a volunteer to take on this role which could suit someone who is a regular walker/road user and has access to a smartphone with a camera to report the information. Training will be given by Oxford County Council. If you are interested, please contact one of the councillors.

Dear Friends

If you could, what new law would you introduce? Perhaps you would like to produce some legislation that protects someone or prevents something or feel it would be to the benefit of the community if certain behaviour was enforced. What would you like to make compulsory?

Of course you might be a very keen advocate for freedom and dislike the idea of rules or you may consider that laws cannot achieve anything because it takes more than a directive to get something done.

Why not have a discussion with your family, friends or neighbours about what law you might introduce?

Christianity, and Lent, the period leading up to Easter in which we are now, is often viewed as following rules and there is no doubt that a disciplined life achieves a great deal and certainly can lead to a deepening of faith but it does not always lead to greater love.

Right at the end of Lent, Jesus came up with a new commandment that we should love one another. And though you can't make anyone love another person, what Jesus did do was to show us by his example of loving us (particularly by his death on the cross) and promise of the gift of his Holy Spirit to help us fulfil this command. Loving is much more an attitude than adherence to strict guidelines. Loving is about giving, wanting others to grow, to develop and enjoy life in all its fullness.

So if you are going to do anything for Lent this year, why not try to be even more loving; perhaps with positive and kind remarks, or by generous and gentle actions or in seeking to be more understanding when irritations occur.

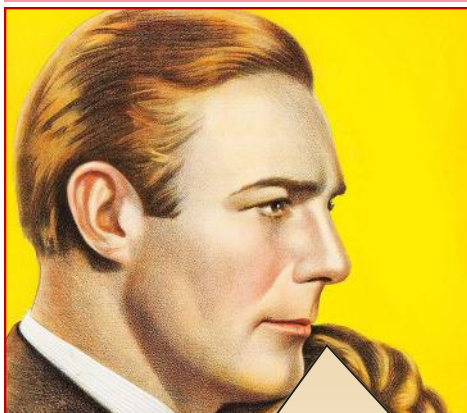

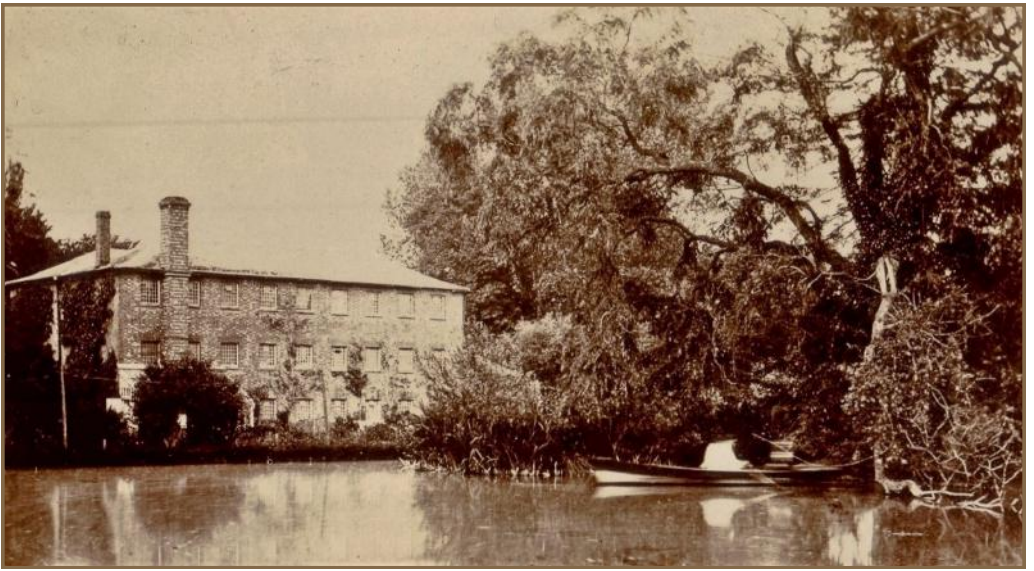
I used to play the triangle in a reggae band, but I soon got bored. I'd stand at the back and...oh, I don't know... it just seemed like it was one ting after another.

Are there hidden threats to guard against in the Hanneys? I believe we remain a very friendly pair of villages with little recorded crime. This week I was amazed to find that had I chosen soon to cycle into Aldworth Close's small new estate, the large iron gates currently being installed would probably have blocked my path. They are also immediately adjacent to the conservation area, if not within it.

Please reassure these new neighbours there that they are safe in the Hanneys and their gates are totally inappropriate and unnecessary in this Vale village? The developer must have misinformed them about the risks they run. The houses in the close are better designs than most recent local developments, but the gates hardly add value, look somewhat over the top and suggest a climate of fear. They should not have been permitted and should be removed. They are more of a folly than a benefit?

Bill, thanks for this. I'm happy to reassure any newcomers that marauding bands of barbarians running amok in the Hanneys are a rare occurrence these days, so not really any need for gates, moats, or drawbridges. Editor

On Tuesday 24th March Hanney History Group will learn about some of the more "interesting" people to be linked to the Hanneys...and as far as Grove! In his talk, "**Hanney Characters through the Ages**", Andrew Robertson will start with contenders such as Walter Giffard. He was a close associate of William the Conqueror and was rewarded by the grant of West Hanney. The Ashcombes of Lyford established charities that remain today. But in the 1680s Sir William Scroggs of East Hanney was known as "*the most detested Lord Chief Justice England has ever had*", and by 1803 the largest landowner in East Hanney was the aptly named John Pollexfen Bastard, who just happened to be MP for Devon and lived near Plymouth. And as for the "goings-on" around post-war Dandridge's Mill...!!

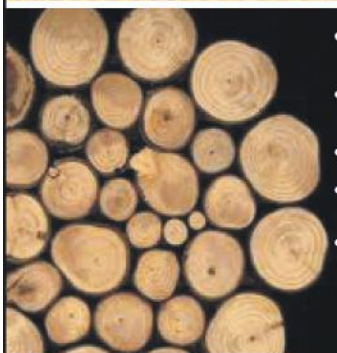

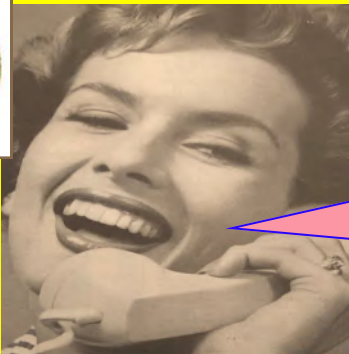
