

In total we sold 140, generating income of £1,400. Our expenses were a total of £653.40p, leaving us with £750, give or take, to distribute to good causes within the community. We have distributed our funds as follows: £150 to the Community shop, £300 to the Hanney Senior Citizens, and £300 to the Hanney Scouts.

Over half our sales were via the shop, so massive thanks to them, and of course to everyone who bought a copy, either there or else-

THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND



How do you know that someone loves you?

How do you show someone that you care for them?

Our words and actions can show others how we feel about them. Gary Chapman wrote about love languages, five ways people demonstrate and receive love. These are through spoken words of affirmation, sharing quality time, with physical touch, in acts of service and by receiving or giving gifts.

It is suggested that we favour certain ways of demonstrating our feelings for someone and prefer certain ways in which we feel loved by others; we might want to show our love by giving gifts and we may feel really cared for when people spend meaningful time with us.

The Christian music artists DC Talk sang that "Love is a verb", a "doing-word" and a way of behaving that combines our thoughts, feelings, words, actions, will and attitudes. It is about what we do and what we choose not to do. In the New Testament love is described in these down to earth and practical terms:

Love is patient and kind, never jealous, boastful, proud, or rude. Love isn't selfish or quick tempered. It doesn't keep a record of wrongs that others do. Love rejoices in the truth but not in evil. Love is always supportive, loyal, hopeful and trusting.

Love never fails!

(1 Corinthians 13 CEV)

This is the way that the Bible calls for us to be treat others and how we should be treated. Another factor that can impact the way we communicate love, is our past experiences. Both our negative and positive past relationships with others can influence and affect our future connections with the people in our lives.

Love is a complicated and dynamic thing. The Bible challenges us that this is the way that we should treat others. We are to have more than just hope and faith in others, we are called to love our neighbours as ourselves, this is a costly and at times uncomfortable instruction as it disrupts our tendency towards self-focus and comfortable routines.

We live in a world where people have demonstrated their capacity to care for neighbours, strangers and refugees. And sadly, we are all to aware of the damage that is caused by a lack of love, care and respect for the lives, wellbeing and rights of others. Yet, it is this world which the Bible informs us that God loved so much, He sent his Son to save it. Being open to God's love for us and this world can help inspire us to love others.

Road Closures

At last the Puffin Crossing on the A338 in East Hanney is to be installed. This is great news, but of course, there will be major disruption during the construction period. Current advise is that work starts on Monday 16th May, finishing Friday 20th May. This means a 24 hour closure for each of the five days to all motor vehicles, though limited access will be maintained for emergency

service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works.

It's highly likely that access into Ashfields Lane and Alfred's Place will be possible from the north, and Anderson Place from the south.

I have not found out the route proposed for the diversion, but it will not involve Ashfields Lane and the East Hanney Village Green. I expect all traffic will be re-routed via Frilford, Marcham, Abingdon, Drayton, and Steventon on the main roads. Further info may be obtained by contacting Nicola

Hanney Historical Calendar.

This month's pic is of the Lamb pub in West Hanney as it was in the late 1920s, early 1930s. The thatched roof looks a bit manky, but the main chimney is very impressive.

The sign on the front of the building reads 'Halls Oxford Brewery

Ltd'. Halls was founded in 1646 as the Swan Brewery, and acquired by William Hall in 1795. It had 300 tied houses when it was acquired by Allsopp & Sons Ltd in 1926. The Hall's brand was retained for many years afterwards, so I don't think the sign necessarily dates our pic at pre 1926. The earliest records of the Lamb's landlords show a Mr Charles Carr in 1847. He was still there in 1851, at which time he employed a servant, 28 year old Sophia Barrett, and he was still in post in 1868. At some point, a Mr Oliver Clinch was the landlord, followed by a Yorkshireman named Ioseph Steel in the 1870s, Ioseph's second wife - his first had died - was a Hanney girl called Mary Watts and they had four children.

By 1887 a John Boor is shown as the landlord, and various records in 1891 show that he had a wife called Martha – they were both aged 32 and also had four children. Sarah Taylor, a niece, was employed as a general domestic servant. She was aged 17 and from East Grinstead. However, other records suggest that in 1891, the Landlord was a Henry Bunce with his wife Barbara.

Further records show John Boor was still there in 1899, or maybe he had a break and returned after Mr Bunce left?
By 1907 John's wife Martha alone was listed, so maybe John had died?
Kellys Directory showed Martha there in 1920, and again in 1924, and 1928.

In 1931 William Boor, son of John and



Martha had taken over. Known as 'Billie' he would have been in his mid-forties, and that's him in our pic, on the far right. I find it odd that he doesn't pose proudly in front of his pub, instead looking rather suspiciously at the camera. (you'll only make out this detail if you're viewing the actual calendar.)

The sign hanging from the post says 'M Boor' on it, so perhaps this pic was taken before Billie took over, when his mum Martha was the licensee? In the early 1930s - some say 1935 - the building burnt down.

As well as losing the pub, there was more bad news. Many irreplaceable local historic records were stored there - I wonder why? - and were all lost in the fire. William was landlord at the time. It was rebuilt and handed down to William's son, John. A Hanney resident, as a boy back in the day, recalls regular visits to the pub when the then landlady, Peggy Nash would happily serve them fizzy pop, crisps and ice -cream. She and her husband Les ran the Lamb for many years. They had two dogs called Jumbo and Nikki, and Peggy was apparently always cheerful.

You don't always find that in landlords these days do you?

The building still stands today, though it closed as a pub in 2008, and is now the very popular Hanney Spice Indian Restaurant, which opened in 2011, attracting connoisseurs of the finest Asian cuisine.


